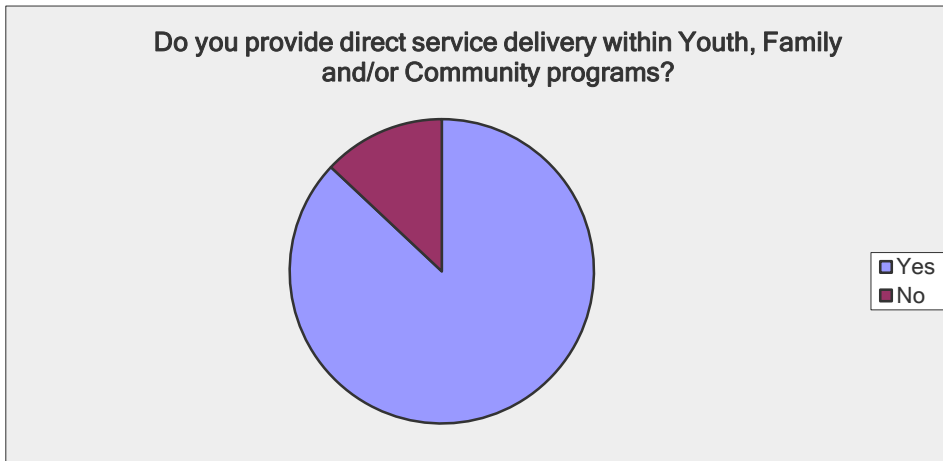

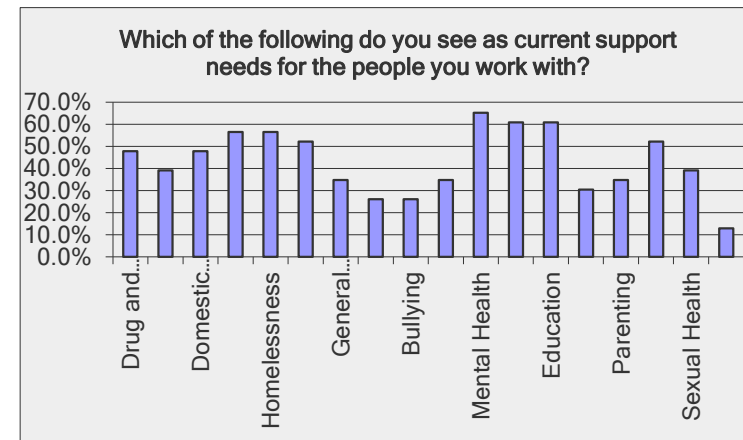
Do you provide direct service delivery within Youth, Family and/or Community programs?

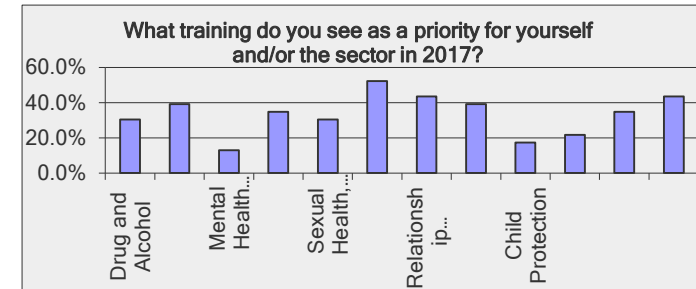

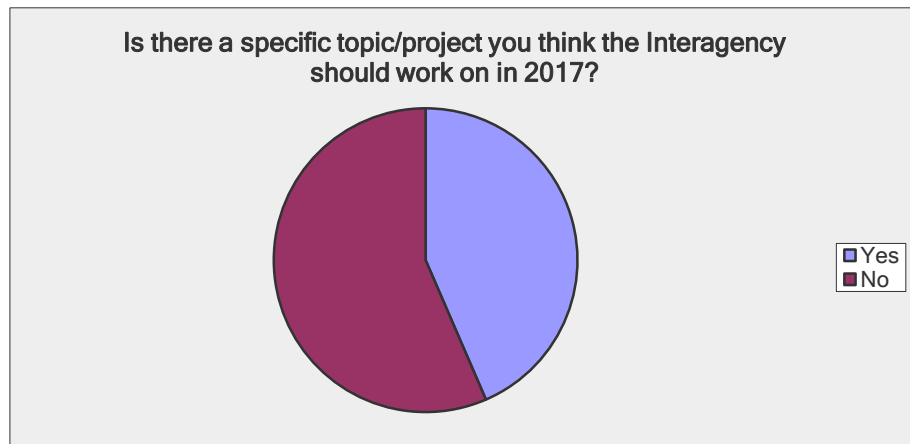
